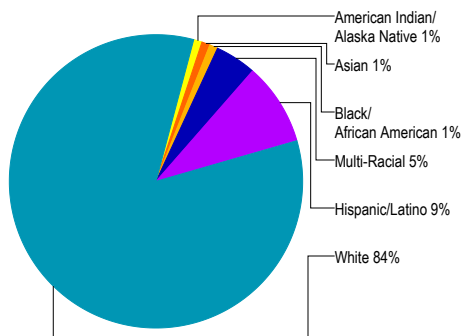

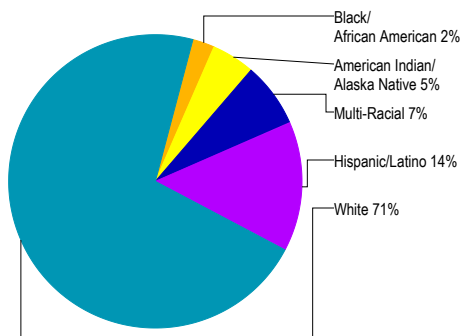

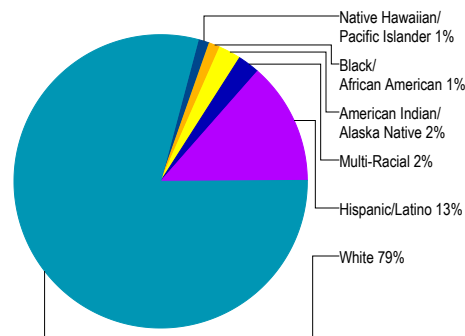
GRADES K - 3 STUDENTS



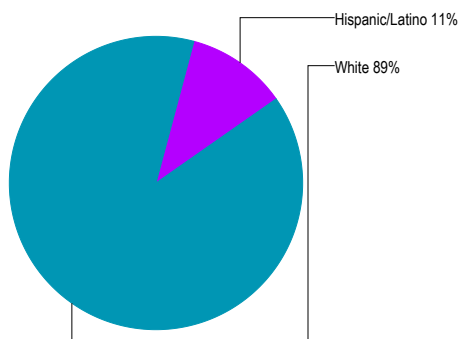
GRADES 4 - 5 STUDENTS



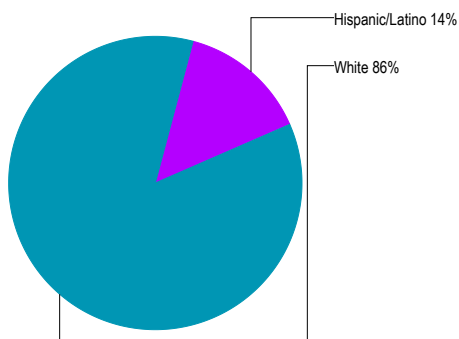

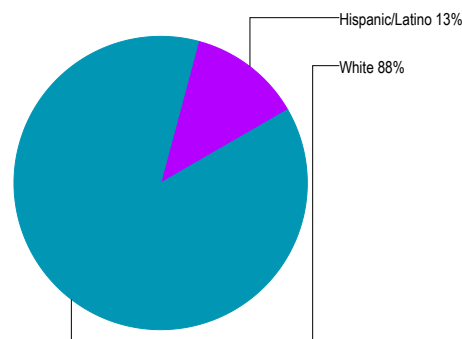

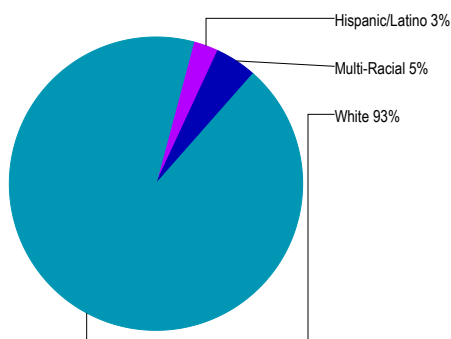

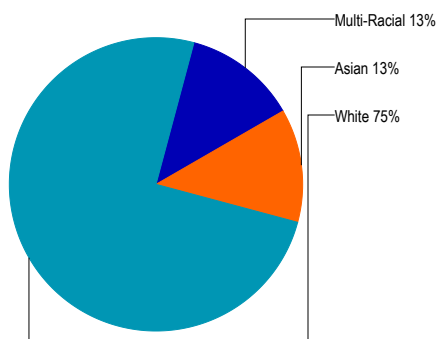

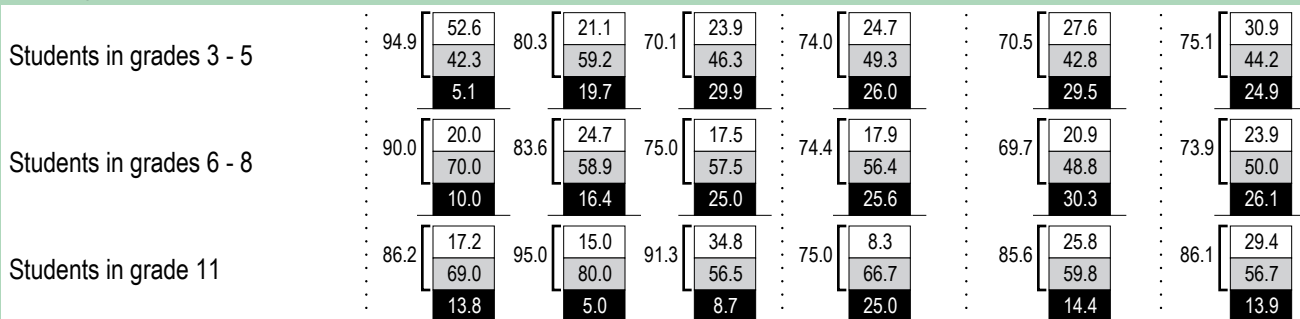

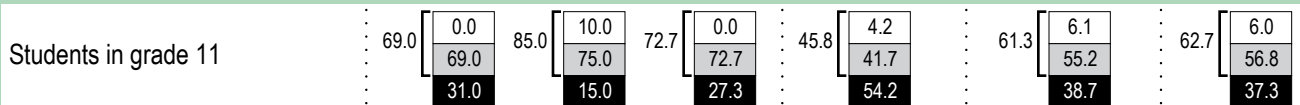

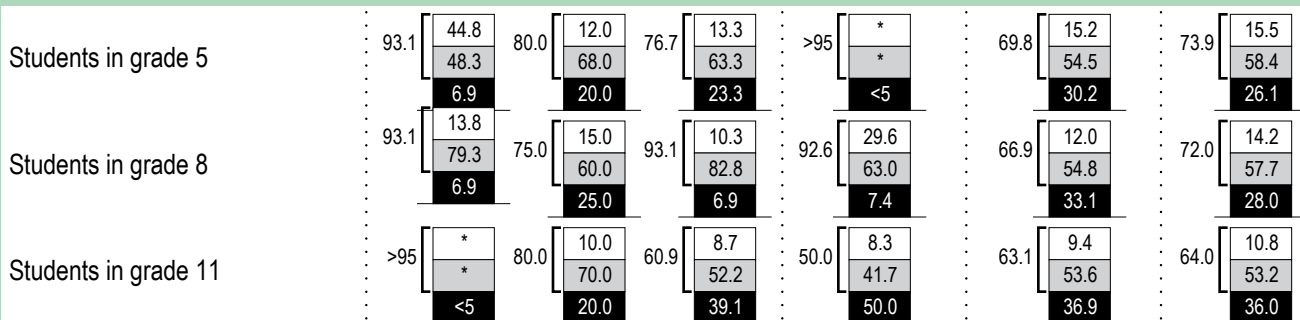
