REPORTING OF HAZARDS

Through routine inspection of all facilities, materials and equipment, as well as through staff training, it is expected that all hazardous or potentially hazardous conditions will be identified, reported and acted upon appropriately.

The superintendent will develop and maintain a written hazard communication program for the district. All personnel who, during the performance of their duties, or in an emergency, may be exposed to hazardous chemicals will be informed and trained to deal appropriately with these chemicals. These employees will be trained to recognize and respond appropriately to the presence of hazardous chemicals.
